

# Who is running for Township and County Councils in fall vote?

"I want people to know." That's why Wellington Ward 8 County Councillor Gordon Tosh was quick off the mark to file his nomination papers on January 11.

Tosh is an unchallenged incumbent candidate in the October 25 municipal election, having served on Wellington County Council for the past 10 years. He was also a Guelph/Eramosa Township councillor from 1991 to 2000 and said he has been involved in a lot of "interesting projects" during his time in public office.

Rockwood firefighter Stephen Liebig threw his hat into the ring on March 18 for the Guelph/ Eramosa Ward 4 seat covering the Rockwood and Everton areas. He unsuccessfully challenged first term Councillor John Scott for the seat in the osa ratepayers. To ensure 2005 election.

Councillors Scott, Doug Breen, Roger Knapp, Rita Moyer, County Councillor Barb McKay and Mayor Chris White have not filed nomination papers to run for the 2011-2014 term.

Voter enumeration forms have recently been sent out to Guelph/Eram-


