To celebrate the International Year of Biodiversity, Conservation Halton is holding its first ever BioBlitz weekend on June 19 and 20 at Hilton Falls with a Family Fun Day on the Saturday and a Naturalist Challenge on both

The BioBlitz Family Fun Day is on Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and is a great opportunity for those who want to learn a little bit more about the natural world in a fun and interactive way. Come out and enjoy themed guided hikes, guest speakers, birds of prey demonstrations, family activities, a BBQ lunch and much more. For those who are passionate about nature, why not join in and compete in Conservation Halton's first BioBlitz Naturalists Challenge! Put together a team or sign up individually and identify as many flora and fauna species that you can over the two days. Prizes will be given out for biggest species list, rarest bird and more. Specialized hikes and demonstrations on dragonflies and damselflies, butterflies, bat study and others will be available

for Naturalists Challenge participants to take part in. Participants must pre-register on the BioBlitz website, www.conservationhalton. ca/bioblitz. This event will be of interest to those who know their sedges from their grasses or their warblers from their sparrows.

Regular gate fees will apply for the BioBlitz weekend at Hilton Falls, annual pass holders can use their vehicle pass for admission.
