Highway 7 Rockwood (GWP 155-91-00)

Detailed Design and Class Environmental Assessment

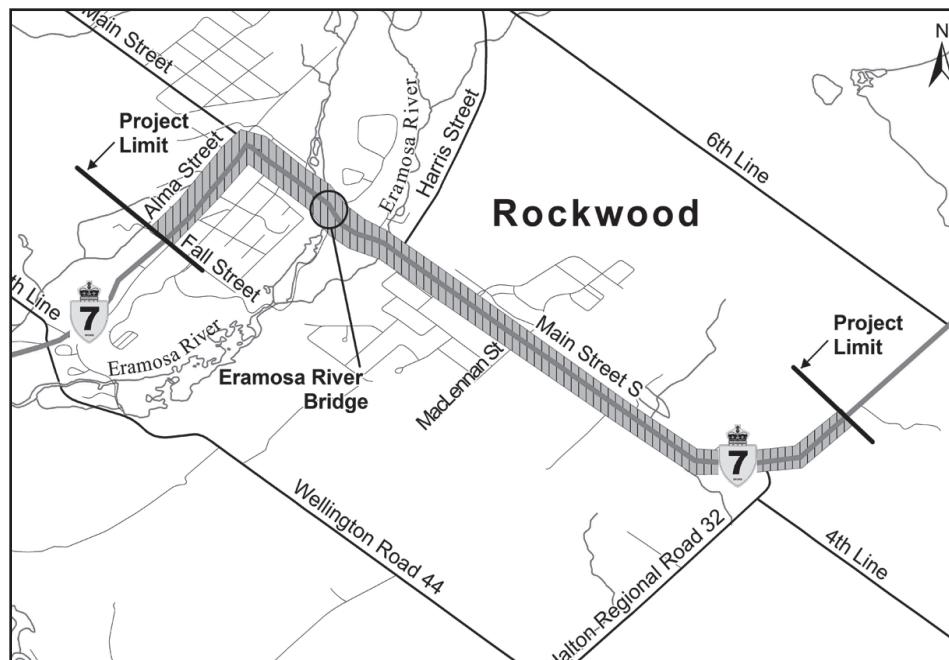
THE PROJECT

Dillon Consulting Limited has been retained by the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) to complete the Detailed Design and Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process for the rehabilitation of 4.1 km of Highway 7 from 0.07 km west of Fall Street to 0.5 km east of Halton Regional Road 32 (to Eden Mills) in the community of Rockwood, Township of Guelph-Eramosa and Town of Milton. Subject to the outcome of the study, the Ministry is proposing:

- Rehabilitation of the roadway to address existing pavement conditions;
- Rehabilitation of the Eramosa River Bridge, with one lane of traffic maintained on the bridge during construction;
- Rehabilitation of the existing storm sewer system, as required;
- Replacement of existing sidewalks, as required;
- Culvert extensions/replacements;
- Modifications to commercial and private entrances as required; and
- Lane closures and local detours, including temporary traffic signals, during construction. Local traffic will be maintained through Rockwood during construction, except for a short duration closure to replace a culvert crossing Highway 7:
 - A detour route for traffic by-passing the community is proposed along Halton Regional Road 32 and Wellington Road 44.
 - Traffic management may include the use of adjacent local roads, including Fall Street and Mary Street/Guelph Street, to limit traffic congestion on Highway 7 during construction.
 - Temporary elimination of on street parking during construction.

A Public Information Centre (PIC) is being held to receive input on the proposed improvements and associated traffic impacts on June 22, 2010. You are invited to attend the PIC to review the displays and speak to members of the Project Team who will be in attendance to present the information, receive comments and answer questions.

THE PROCESS

This study is subject to Ontario's *Environmental Assessment Act* and is being carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for Provincial Transportation Facilities (2000) as a Group 'B' project. A Transportation Environmental Study Report describing the existing conditions, preferred design and environmental mitigating measures and provisions that have been incorporated into the design will be prepared for a 30-day public review period near the end of the study.

COMMENTS

Comments and information collected will be used in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and the *Access to Information Act*. With the exception of personal information, all comments will become part of the public record.
