

Did you know? Plastic plant pots and plastic plant trays are not accepted in the Blue Box because the plastic can be difficult to process with other acceptable plastic materials.

If you have unwanted plant pots, take them back to these local businesses and organizations. Conditions apply; please check with the retailer when dropping off materials.
