New this year is the "Safety Village" in the parking lot of the Peekaboo Day Care Centre. Back by popular demand is the Halton Hills Fire Department with a fire truck and the "Get 'Em Out Alive" Smoke House. The Masonic Child Identification Program (CHIP) will be in the Safety Village as well. The CHIP programs allow parents the opportunity to create a kit of identifying ma-

terials for their child, free of charge. The kit contains a fingerprint card, a physical description, a video, computer disk, or DVD of the child, a dental imprint, and a DNA sample. The purpose of the kit is to provide critical information to the public and to law enforcement in the event that a child goes missing. The program has been lauded by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. Plus the Halton Regional Police Service Children's Safety Village, were children can practice their driving skills and receive a safe driving certificate from Mayor Rick. The Roxy Kids Zone is also new. Kids can do rock painting, balloon art and face painting while being entertained by Freddie Fusion and the Dominos Pizza Eating Contest.

Don't forget to check out the "Old French Market" on Willow St. and make some groceries and be entertained by "The Classics" featuring Jim Dunham and his Cajun style ensemble.
