## Acton man plays lead in RENT at Rose Theatre

he was "very exited and terrified" to be playing the lead role in Rent, opening November 11 at the Rose Theatre in Brampton.

Performing at the Rose is as much of a thrill as winning the lead role for Grimason.

"I've had some nice roles before, but this is an amazing role – a lot of the subject matter is in regards to AIDS, and it's based in New York City. My part is kind of like the narrator, I'm a character in it but I kind of narrate the story," Grimason said recently.

The rock opera, set on a Christmas Eve in the late 1990s, follows a year in the lives of the characters. Although it sounds dark, Grimason said it is also "comical and hopeful, as opposed to depressing."

Grimason, a Mississauga RBC bank manager who moved to Acton five years ago and has a young family, heard about the role on Facebook, and won the Brampton Music Theatre audition.

"It's a little scary – we have a great professional director who also does community theatre – and we've worked three nights a week for 10 weeks...we've done it all on chunks and now we are putting it together,"


Acton's David Grimason was not acting when he said he said, adding he loves to sing, but the part calls for

"I wanted a challenge and I got it," Grimason said, adding he played in a few high school productions, but didn't seriously get involved in community theatre until approximately 15 years ago when he "blindly" auditioned for a Mississauga theatre group show, got the part and has been "hooked ever since."

Grimason's most memorable roles have been Joseph in Joseph and the Technicolor Dream Coat in Etobicoke, and had the lead in Miss Saigon.

Acting is a hobby – with an 18-month-old toddler and son at Robert Little School Grimason can only do one production a year, which he does "for fun." He takes different parts for different reasons, and said this show was for the challenge of working with people he did not know, in a show that has not been done locally in community theatre at a beautiful venue.
