Are you using **acceptable GreenCart liners?**

If you choose to line your GreenCart with a bag, please ensure you are using and purchasing acceptable GreenCart liners. Not all liners sold are accepted for use in Halton's GreenCart program. Halton Region does not accept plastic products or plastic liners in the GreenCart.



If purchasing liners, ensure you only select certified compostable liners with the Biodegradable Products Institute (BPI) logo on the box, as shown to the right. These bags are made from plant-based materials so they compost easily.



Other acceptable liners include:

- Paper towels
- Paper bags
- Newspaper/flyers
- Paper food waste bags
- Cardboard

- GreenCart:**
 - Candy and chocolate (no wrappers)
 - Paper bags
 - Potato chips (no bags)
- Yard Waste:**
 - Pumpkins
 - Decorative cornstalks
 - Decorative hay bales (must be bundled and weigh no more than 23 kg (50 lbs))
- Garbage:**
 - Candy and chocolate wrappers
 - Plastic lollipop sticks
 - Artificial decorations
 - Potato chip bags (including compostable)

Reuse: Many items in good condition can be taken to a local reuse centre. Costumes • Clothing • Shoes (paired)
