WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION STATEMENT

There were 5,596 accidents reported to the Workmen's Compensation Board during the month of October...

The fatal cases numbered 28, as against 20 in September, and 33 last October.

The total benefits awarded amounted to \$5,178,781.01, of which \$434,917.01 was for compensation and \$4,743,864.00 for medical aid.

This brings the total benefits awarded to date this year to \$4,461,922.86, as compared with \$3,668,828.62 during the same period last year...
