ORGANIZATION AND CONSTRUCTION.

The present company was incorporated in May last for the purpose of purchasing the properties and franchises of the Bluff City Electric Railway company, and to complete and operate the line from Wankegan to Evanston.

In 1896 the Bluff City company built and operated a street railway line from Wankegan to North Chicago, acquiring also certain other rights of way and franchises which passed into the hands of the Chicago & Milwaukee Electric Railway Company in May last. The new_company began at once active construction in the extension of the road toward Evanston, and have already complete and in successful operation, eighteen miles of single track line, extending

from the northern limits of Wau-

kegan to the southern limits of


heavy steel upon a perfect road bed, and equipped with large and first-class double truck passenger coaches, having each two 50 H.P. motors, capable of maintaining a speed of from 30 to 40 miles per hour. The electric system adopted is particularly commendable and the road bed, generating, transforming and distributing apparatus represent the highest type of electric railway engineering of the day.

Between Highland Park and Waukegan the company has now in service eighteen cars, taking care of the ordinary present traffic with from eight to ten motor cars. All the coaches are, and will be painted a royal blue, with gold lettering and ornamentation, and the system will be known under the euphonious and appropriate title of "The Royal Blue Line."
