

## WILL PUSH CONSTRUCTION.

Before the first of next July the residents all along the North Shore, between Highland Park and Evanston will be in the full enjoyment of the superb system of inter-urban transportation which the Chicago &


has been assiduously at work to acquire right of way from Highland Park to Evanston and every effort has been made to secure equitable franchises and to avoid the necessity of condemnation proceedings or co-The right of way has now ercion. nearly all been secured through to Evanston and a contract has been let for the entire construction of a double track line from the present Highland Park terminus to Llewellyn Park from which point it is expected that the cars will run over the Milwaukee railway tracks to Davis St, Evanston.

Under the terms of this contract the road will be completed, and the cars in operation on July first and an extra inducement of attractive size is offered the contractors to finish their work earlier. These contracts have "saving clauses" where right of way has not been secured.

Contracts have also been let for the entire electrical construction as well as for a large extension of the By its liberal methods, splendid service and the exact fulfilment of every promise made to this time the C. & M.
