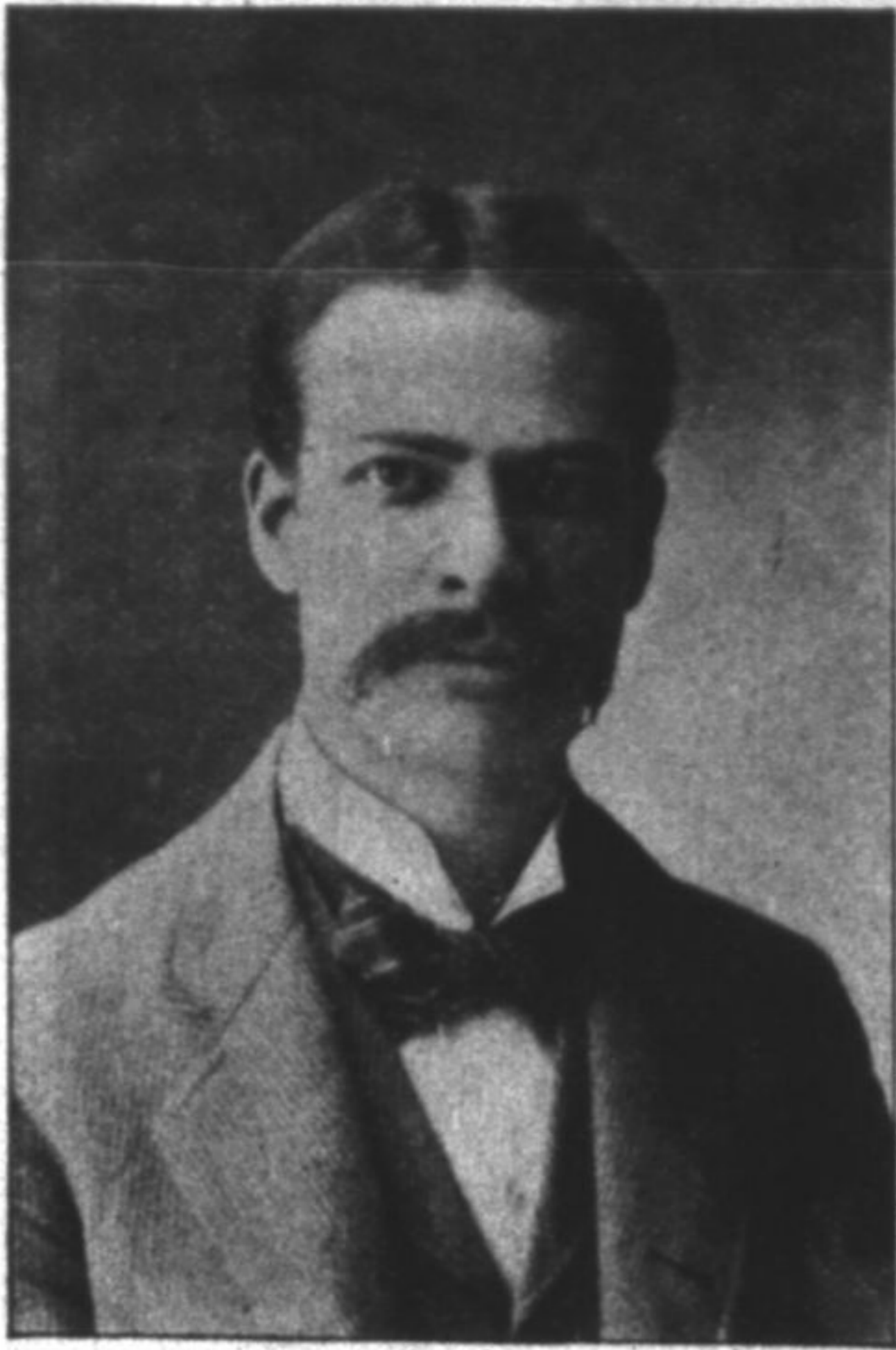


Mr. David A. Holmes,

Was re-elected alderman in the

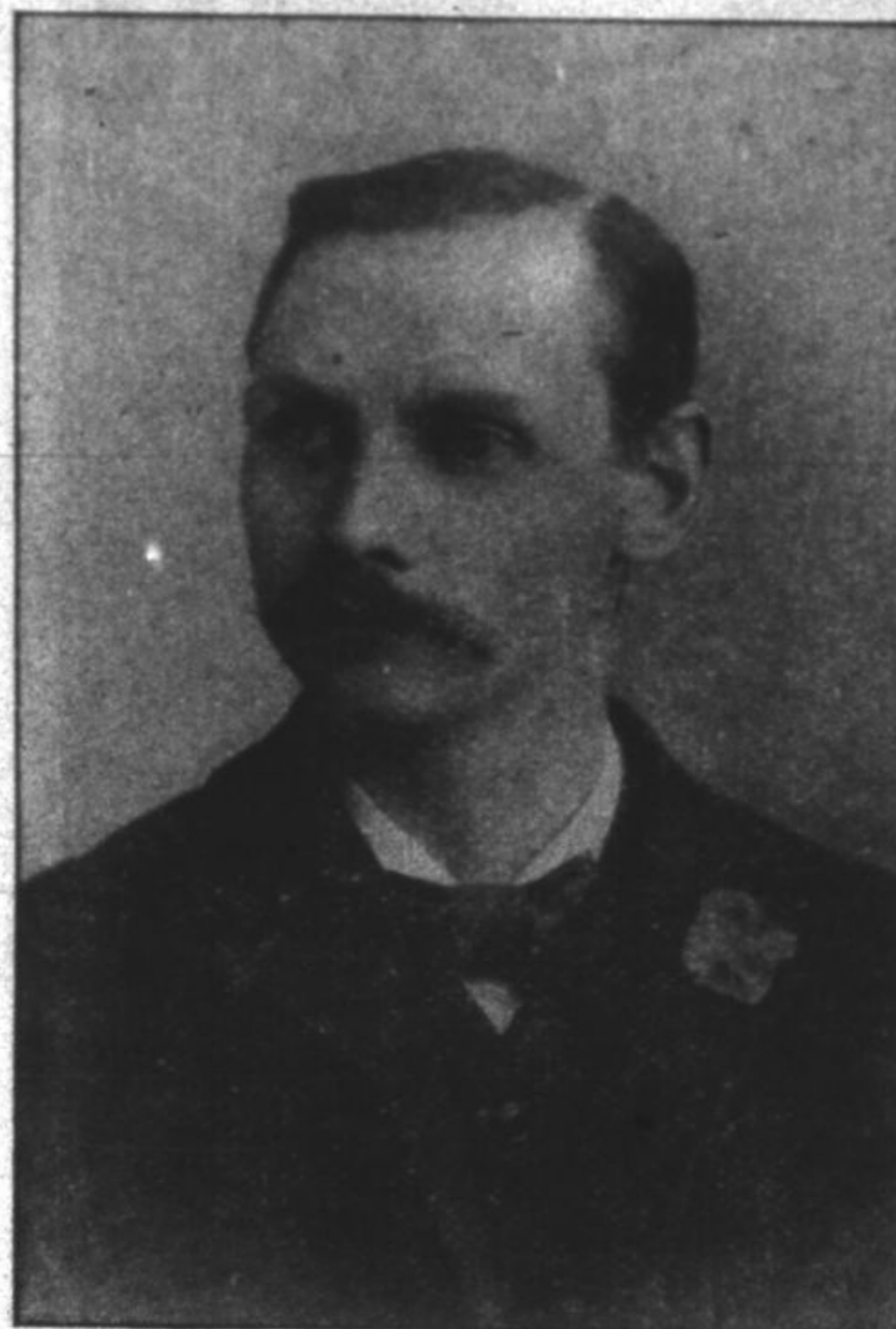
first ward by a goodly majority. Mr. McCaffrey was the only alderman on the ticket elected, which fact is gratifying to his many friends.
