GLENCOE SCHOOL.

On Tuesday, September 5th, the new school will be opened. Not only is the repaired and renovated building new once more after its fiery baptism but in many other ways the school will be new.

The public kindergarten will be an established fact, under the charge of Miss Louise Webster and Miss Sarah S. Hammond, both able and experienced kindergarteners.

The manual training classes, compulsory for boys and optional for girls, will be held on Fridays and will be directed by Mr. Frank A. Windes who has been very successful in that line.

The high school classes will be given up for the reason that the township high school board has arranged to pay the tuition of all first and second year high school pupils at Winnetka while third and fourth year pupils may attend Evanston high school at the expense of this township.

The first to eighth grades of our school will be under the same corps of teachers as during the past year, but even there there will be change as pupils will be advanced only on

their standing during the term instead of passing examinations, while the monthly reports of pupils will be "good," "poor," etc, instead of on a per centage basis.

There will be another high school election on Sept. 2d, to authorize the erection of a high school building.
