A Valuable Volume.

Several years ago we began collecting the published ordinances of Highland Park until a few months since, when having secured a complete set, as we think, we had the bound in a substantial volume...

We had a long search for the first issue, but finally while looking over the large collection of legal blanks in the office of John Middleton...

The second edition of the ordinance was published in 1880, the first therefore being passed March 1, 1874...

That was twenty-five years ago W. W. Boyington was mayor. The first ordinance in that pamphlet was one to prevent the "running at large of animals..."

The third edition was brought out in 1885, under the editorial care of Kenneth R. Smoot, as city attorney, Dr. Sweetland as mayor, and John Finney as city clerk...

The fourth edition came out in 1892. Kenneth R. Smoot, city attorney, John Finney clerk, Banker David M. Erskine, jr., mayor, Fred Russell marshal, Lewis B. Hibbard, police magistrate. That edition contained 108 pages.

The fifth and last edition came out in 1898. Kenneth R. Smoot, city attorney, editing the same, making a pamphlet of 206 pages. It is prefaced with a historical note of a little over one page, also a list of mayors from F. P. Hawkins to the present mayor, Robert G. Evans and John Finney was still our city clerk...
