Our Water Works Intake Pipe was found to be in such a dangerous condition that immediate and permanent repairs were necessary in order to insure its safety. Driftwood and in many places the sand was washed from its own weight, but fortunately spend \$1,500 for removing the pipe, and in order to rush the services of two divers were employed.

The repairs are now complete and the photograph herewith shows the Fire and Water Committee in a diving suit, just about to be lowered from shore, to inspect the work done according to contract. This undertaking was purely a volunteer act on his part, and the city thereby saves \$50, the amount usually paid an inspecting diver from Chicago.
