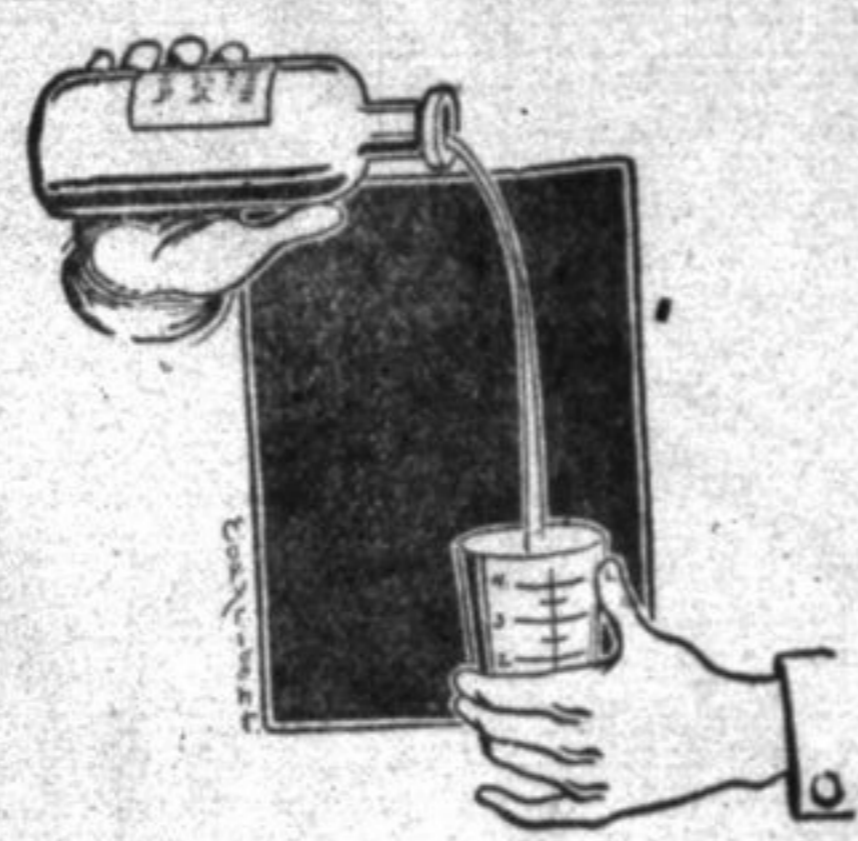
Spain's Work Slaves.
