TOWN MEETING.

The regular town meeting came off Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, in McDonald's hall. W. O. Hipwell was chairman and H. M. Prior was clerk. Supervisor McDonald reported \$1,768.75 cash in the bank, and recommended that no levy be made, and it was so ordered. He

be paid at once—they are fixed by law—and not make the people wait till fall for their money, and it was done. Highway Commissioner Hessler's report was read and approved. Chairman Hipwell made a short speech congratulating the town on its fine financial condition and its careful and prudent business management. Being a successful banker for years, Mr. Hipwell knows what good business management means. The meeting adjourned in the best of spirits.

MANY EXTENSIONS.

The North Shore Gas Company continues to be favored with a growth of business which will mean much in the way of additional equipment for service this season. Plans are under way for adding to the gas mains already laid in Lake Forest and Highland Park, and the services will be fully doubled. The constant
