AN ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN Ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Revising and Consolidating the General Ordinances of the City of Highland Park, County of Lake and State of Illinois."

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Highland Park:

SECTION 1. That Section 422 of Chapter 46, "Streets," of an ordinance of said City, entitled "An Ordinance Revising and Consolidating the General Ordinances of the City of Highland Park, County of Lake and State of Illinois," passed April 29, 1898, be amended to read as follows:

Whenever any part of any street, alley, sidewalk or other public place in the City of Highland Park shall be torn up, dug up or taken up for any purpose, all paving, planking, cross-walks, graveling or macadamizing, if any, taken up or dug up, shall be relaid in a skillful and permanent manner, and in as good condition as it or they were before, and in every case to the satisfaction and approval of the Street and Alley Committee of said City and under its direction or the direction of its duly authorized agent, and wherever in any of the work in this section provided for, it shall become necessary to make any excavation or do any digging or taking up of any earth, all earth taken, dug or excavated shall be completely removed from the place where excavated and the excavated space occupied by said earth completely back-filled with sand, which shall be rammed and packed down as fast as returned, to a firm and solid bearing and in such a manner as to entirely prevent any settling or the settling of any pavement, graveling, macadamizing, sidewalk or cross-walk resting thereon.

Any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this Section, or who shall neglect or refuse to do said work in manner as herein provided, shall be fined in the sum of not less than Fifteen Dollars nor more than Two Hundred Dollars for each offense, and where such violation shall be made by a licensed plumber or sewer builder, in addition to the penalties hereinabove provided, the license of such plumber or sewer builder shall be revoked by the City Council and he shall not be entitled to a new license for the space of six months after the date of such revocation.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
