

**"A CORKER."**

In praising the new electric headlight just installed on a street car on the Fox Lake line, the Gazette says:

"The electric headlight is certainly a great success. An evidence of its power is that when the car was at the west city limits the light could be seen at the east end of the line and from Butrick street to West street the light is thrown with an intensity to cast a distinct shadow.

"Such a light must certainly be a great safeguard against accidents and they should be in use on electric cars generally. The enterprise of the new railroad in being the first to adopt it here is commended."

This same style of electric headlight was tried some two or three years ago on Wentworth avenue cars in Chicago and had to be abandoned owing to the intense glare thrown in the motorman's face on an approaching car. It is presumed the Fox Lake line only have one car at present with them on.
