STUDENTS' MUSEUM.
An effort is being made to provide the schools of Highland Park with a museum which may be useful as an aid to school work. Already two or three hundred specimens have been secured. These are carefully labeled and assorted, the more valuable ones being kept behind glass for greater security. A catalogue, corresponding to the labels, and giving the name and number of each specimen, the locality from which obtained, the giver's name and any other interesting fact will also be kept in the school to give more permanency and utility to the collection.

A room has been set apart both at the high school and at the grammar school for museum purposes.

Persons wishing to help in this valuable work by contributing one or more specimens are urged to communicate with the committee whose names appear below, giving the names of the specimens which it is proposed to give, the source from which obtained, and any other interesting or important fact. The material desired includes the following:

1. Geological Specimens.—Metals, minerals and fossils.
2. Zoological Specimens.—Stuffed birds and animals, skins of birds, shells; butterflies and other insects.
3. Botanical Specimens.—Mounted plants and mosses.
4. Historical Specimens.—Specimens of historic interest, such as documents, autographs; remembrances of great men, etc.
5. Pictures.—Historic scenes, great men, scientists, statesmen, poets, painters, etc.; illustrations of literary masterpieces; types of architecture; animals and their habits; men, their dress and occupations;
