sidewalks according to ordinance in

Work, on the following named streets:
East side of Railroad avenue from
Beach street to Cedar avenue.
North side of Beach street from St.
Johns avenue to Sheridan road.
South side of Roger Williams avenue
from Railroad to Judson avenue.
West side of Sheridan road from
Broadway south a distance of 132 feet.
South side of Broadway from Sheri-
dan road west a distance of 132 feet.
North side of Bronson street from
Rice street, 265 feet east and 206 feet
west.

AN ORDINANCE.

Levying Taxes For Corporate Purposes
For the Fiscal Year from May 1,
1905 to April 30, 1906.

SECTION 1.—That whereas the total
amount of all appropriations legally
made for all corporate purposes and to
be collected from the tax levy of the
fiscal year of said city ending April 30,
1906, having been ascertained by said
City Council to be the sum of Twenty-
three thousand eight hundred and
twenty-three (23,823.00) dollars and the
purpose for which appropriations are
made and the sum or amount appro-
priated for each purpose being as fol-
lows:

STREETS, ALLEYS AND BRIDGES.	
For constructing, maintaining and repairing streets, alleys and bridges.....	\$3,000.00
SEWERS.	
For constructing, maintain- ing and repairing sewers..	700.00
STREET LIGHTING.	
For street Lighting for year	4,600.00
LIBRARY.	
For Library purposes.....	1,200.00
SALARY OF OFFICERS.	
For salaries of City officers..	5,792.00
MISCELLANEOUS	
For Miscellaneous purposes.	241.00
BOND AND INTEREST	
For Bonded Indebtedness and Interest falling due.....	8,290.00
