

What People Are Doing in Highwood

The hopes of the property owners near the present reservation are speedily reaching fulfillments, as the government is steadily buying all the property on which it secured options some time ago. The present outlook seems to indicate that the reservation will be enlarged at an early date, but just how extensive the improvements will be has not yet been given out, if in fact it is yet known. There is a rumor that certain properties will be secured by condemnation proceedings, although options had been secured. There is no reason given for this, but it is supposed that some irregularity in the papers is the cause. The matter of enlarging the reservation is a vital one to the city, as it will mean many changes from the established order of things. For one thing many of the present saloons will have to change location if not be suspended altogether.

There was this week introduced into the general assembly at Springfield, a bill providing for a prohibition zone four miles in extent around every army post in the State. It is expected that the bill will be fought strenuously by the liquor manufacturers, as such a law, if passed, would wipe out a very large number of saloons. In this city, for example, if such a law were passed, every saloon would be closed, and, as the prohibition zone already extends more than four miles in every direction, with the exception of Highwood, there would not be any saloons nearer than Libertyville or North Chicago. Such a bill would sound the death knell to Highwood.
