NOTICE FOR LETTING CONTRACT.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That bids will be received for the construction of a sewer from and connecting with the manhole now located in the public sewer in Deerfield Avenue, at the point where the center line of McDaniel Avenue produced north in its course intersects said manhole, thence south along said center line produced north and along the center line of said McDaniel Avenue for a distance of 1135 feet, with house junctions and flushing connection; as a whole, in accordance with the ordinance therefor. Said bids will be opened on the 7th day of June, A. D., 1907, at the hour of 10 a. m. at the office of the Board of Local Improvements of said city in the City building.

The specifications for such improvement and blank proposals will be furnished at the office of the City Clerk of said city in the City building.

The contractor will be paid in bonds which bonds will draw interest at the rate of Five (5) per cent per annum.

All proposals or bids must be accompanied by a certified check payable to the order of the President of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Highland Park for a sum not less than ten (10) per centum of the aggregate of the proposal. Said proposals or bids must be delivered to the President of the Board of Local Improvements in open session of said board at the time and place fixed herein for opening the same. No proposal or bid will be considered unless accompanied by a check as herein provided.

The Board of Local Improvements reserve the right to reject any or all bids should they deem it best for the the public good.
