

### AN ORDINANCE

#### Levying Taxes for Corporate Purposes for the Fiscal Year From May 1, 1907, to April 30, 1908.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Highland Park, County of Lake, and State of Illinois:

Section 1. That whereas the total amount of all appropriations legally made for all corporate purposes and to be collected from the tax levy of the fiscal year of said city, ending April 30, 1908, having been ascertained by said City Council to be the sum of twenty-six thousand five hundred and seventy-six dollars (\$26,576.00), and the purposes for which appropriations are made and the sum of amount appropriated for each purpose being as follows:

STREETS, ALLEYS AND BRIDGES.	
For constructing, maintaining and repairing streets, alleys and bridges.....	\$ 3,800.00
SALARY OF OFFICERS.	
For salaries of city officers....	4,804.00
STREET LIGHTING.	
For street lighting purposes....	4,000.00
LIBRARY.	
For public library purposes....	1,200.00
BOND AND INTEREST.	
For bonded indebtedness and interest falling due.....	11,702.00
MISCELLANEOUS.	
For miscellaneous corporate purposes not hereinabove enumerated .....	1,070.00

TOTAL APPROPRIATED.....\$26,576.00

Now, therefore, said City Council does hereby levy said twenty-six thousand five hundred and seventy-six dollars (\$26,576.00) upon all property subject to taxation within said city as the same is assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for the current year, as the city taxes for the City of Highland Park, for said year ending April 30, 1908.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of this ordinance, duly certified with the County Clerk of Lake County, State of Illinois, on or before Sept. 16th, 1907.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.

#### SPECIAL ASSESSMENT NOTICE Special Warrant No. 110.

Public notice is hereby given that the County Court of Lake County, Illinois, has rendered judgment for a special assessment upon property benefited by the following improvement:

For the grading, paving with macadam and otherwise improving a system of streets in the City of Highland Park, County of Lake, and State of Illinois, as follows: Onwentsia Avenue from the westerly line of First Street, thence west to the east line of Exmoor Avenue, Midlothian Avenue, from its intersection with a line eleven (11) feet north of and parallel with the center line of Homewood Avenue, thence north along said Midlothian Avenue and Midlothian Avenue produced, to its junction, with a line eleven (11) feet south of and parallel with the center line of Onwentsia Avenue (except where said Midlothian Avenue intersects the paved roadway of Vine Avenue, and except where it intersects the roadway herein ordered to be paved on Glenview Avenue) and Glenview Avenue and Homewood Avenue from the west line of Green Bay Road, thence west to the east line of Exmoor Avenue, as will more fully appear from the certified copy of the judgment on file in my office. Notice is further given that said assessment is divided into 10 installments. That the amount of the first installment is \$2,085.00, and that each of the remaining installments is \$1,700.00. That all installments draw interest at the rate of five (5) per cent per annum from December 27th, 1906.

The second installment one year thereafter, and so on annually until all installments are paid.

#### SPECIAL ASSESSMENT NOTICE Special Assessment No. 122.

Public notice is hereby given that the County Court of Lake County, Illinois, has rendered judgment for a special assessment upon property benefited by the following improvement:

For the construction of a cast-iron lateral main water supply pipe, together with fire hydrants, shut-off valves and special castings, to be constructed and laid along and under Green Bay Road, from and connecting with the southerly terminus of the present water main now laid in Green Bay Road, at a point in said roadway about twelve (12) feet easterly from the center line thereof and 350 feet southerly from the south line of the north  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the northwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26, Township 43, north Range 12, thence southerly along said Green Bay Road on a line parallel with and twelve (12) feet easterly from the center line of said Green Bay Road, said distance being measured on a line at right angles to said center line, for a distance of 1,230 feet, in the City of Highland Park, County of Lake, and State of Illinois, as will more fully appear from the certified copy of the judgment on file in my office. #### SPECIAL ASSESSMENT NOTICE Special Warrant No. 120.

Public notice is hereby given that the County Court of Lake County, Illinois, has rendered judgment for a special assessment upon property benefited by the following improvement:

For the construction of a cast-iron lateral main water supply pipe, together with fire hydrants, shut-off valves and special castings, to be constructed and laid along and under Moraine Road and Montgomery Avenue, commencing at and connecting with the water main now laid in Moraine Road at a point about 400 feet westerly from the westerly line of Sheridan Road, and twelve

feet north of the center line of said Moraine Road, thence westerly on a line parallel with and twelve feet northerly from the center line of said Moraine Road to and connecting with the water main now laid in St. John's Avenue, said water main to be laid in Montgomery Avenue shall connect with the water main herein provided for to be built in Moraine Road at a point in said main which would be intersected by a line drawn parallel with and ten feet east of the center line of said Montgomery Avenue produced north in its course across said Moraine Road, thence south on a line parallel with and ten feet east of said center line produced and the center line of said Montgomery Avenue to a point in said line twenty-five feet north of the southerly terminus of said Montgomery Avenue, in the City of Highland Park, County of Lake, and State of Illinois, as will more fully appear from the certified copy of the judgment on file in my office.
