That whereas the total amount of all appropriations legally made for all corporate purposes and to be collected from the tax levy of the fiscal year of said city, ending April 30, 1908, having been ascertained by said City Council to be the sum of twentysix thousand five hundred and seventysix dollars (\$26,576.00), and the purposes for which appropriations are made and the sum or amount appropriated for each purpose being as follows:

For salaries of city officers... STREET LIGHTING. For street lighting purposes... LIBRARY.

For public library purposes.... 1,200.00 BOND AND INTEREST. For bonded indebtedness and interest falling due...... 11,702.00

MISCELLANEOUS. For miscellaneous corporate purposes not hereinabove enumerated 1,070.00
