**LONDON DETECTIVES TRACK A THIEF FOR NEARLY FIVE YEARS.**

A Scotland Yard detective is reported to have arrested in Merced, Cal., two men who are accused of having committed a two hundred thousand dollar jewel robbery at London nearly five years ago. The accused men it is said, waived extradition and expressed a willingness to return to London at once. It is reported that the detective and his prisoners left for New York Sunday, Jan. 12, on the Santa Fe Overland.

The story did not become public until now. According to the story told four years ago last April the home of a wealthy resident of London was robbed of a large amount of jewelry, valued at \$200,000. Simultaneously with the burglary the groom and butler employed in the house disappeared. The detectives of Scotland Yard traced the men around the world.

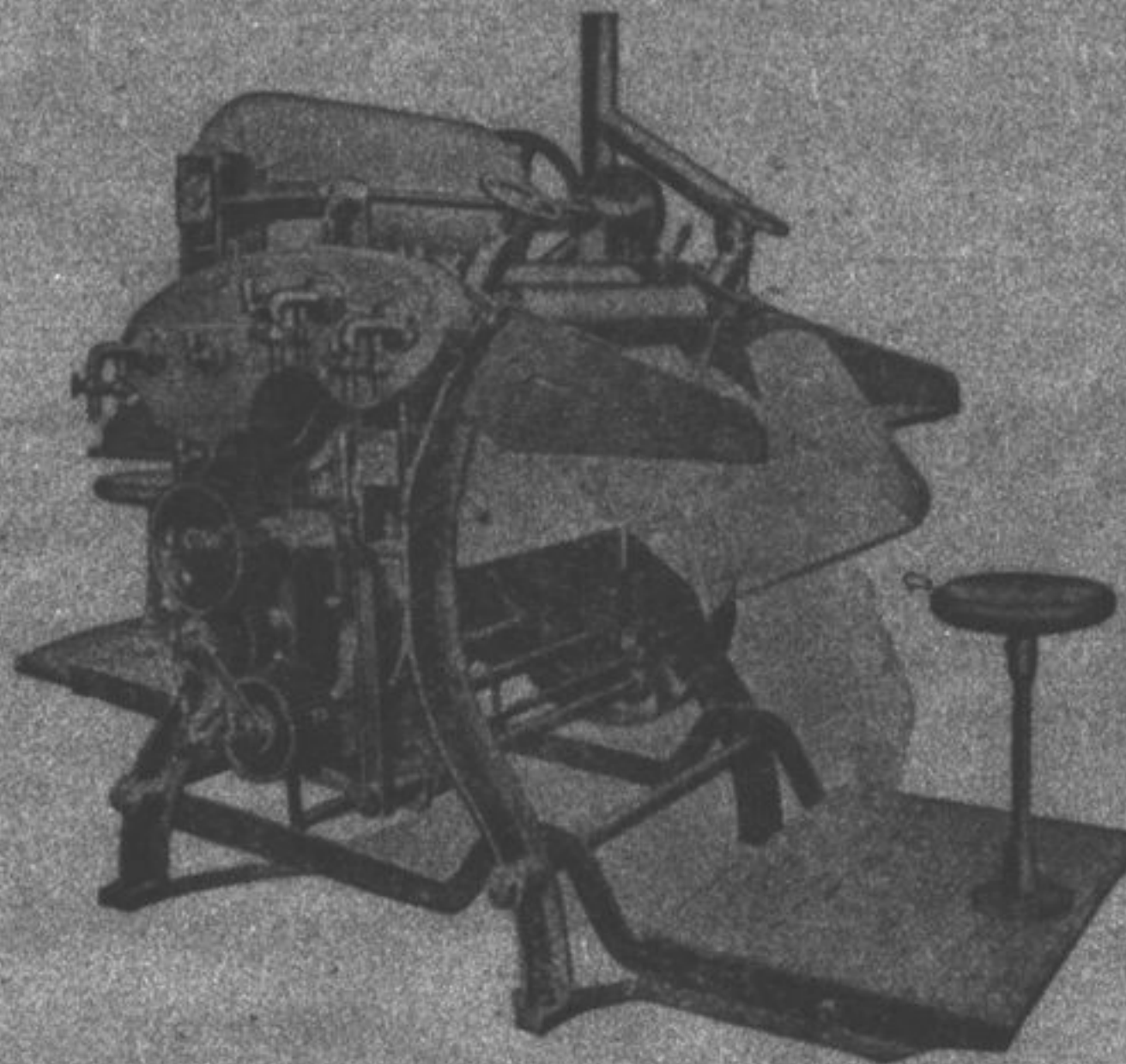
