Notice is hereby given to all persons interested that the bids for the construction of a cast iron internal main water supply pipe ten (10) inches internal diameter together with fire hydrants, shut off valves and special castings to be constructed and laid along and under Linden Avenue, Cedar Avenue and Sheridan Road in the City of Highland Park from and connecting with the water main now laid at the intersection of Linden Avenue and Lincoln Avenue thence southerly along said Linden Avenue to Cedar Avenue thence easterly along said Cedar Avenue to Sheridan Road, thence easterly and southerly along said Sheridan Road to and connecting with the water main now laid in Roger Williams Avenue.
