Ald. McPherson moved, seconded by Ald. Everhart that the report of the commissioner of Public Works be accepted and that the recommendations concurred in. Carried. Ayes All.

Ald. Stevens moved, seconded by Ald. Bahr that the Finance Committee be and it is hereby authorized and directed to secure bids for an audit of the books and systemizing of accounts of the City Clerk and City Treasurer and to report such bids to the City Council at the next regular meeting. Motion was carried.

Ald. Doty moved seconded by Ald. Bahr that the Mayor be instructed to appoint a committee of three to draft resolutions concerning the death of the City Treasurer, thereupon the Mayor appointed Ald. Doty, McPherson and Bahr members of said committee.

Ald. Doty reported the dangerous condition of the platform on the west side of the North Western Railway station and on motion of Ald. McPherson seconded by Ald. Everhart, the Commissioner of Public Works was instructed to investigate the same.

Owing to the death of the City Treasurer, Ald. Stevens moved seconded by Ald. Bahr that Fred Greenslade be appointed to fill the unexpired term of said office. Carried. Ayes. Ald. Tillman, Kline, Everhart, McPherson, Doty, Stevens and Bahr.

Ald. Doty moved seconded by Ald. Bahr a suspension of the rules for the purpose of acting upon the appropriation for the bond of the City Treasurer. Motion was carried.

Ald. Doty moved seconded by Ald. Bahr that the new City Treasurer be instructed to obtain a surety bond same to be approved by the Mayor and that the premium on said bond be paid by the City of Highland Park. Carried. Ayes Ald. Tillman, Kline, Everhart, McPherson, Doty, Stevens and Bahr.

Ald. Doty moved seconded by Ald. McPherson a suspension of the rules for the purpose of acting upon bills. Motion was carried.

Ald. Stevens moved seconded by Ald. Doty that all bills properly audited be paid and that the City Clerk be authorized to draw warrants upon the proper funds in payment of same. Carried. Ayes Ald. Tillman, Kline, McPherson, Everhart, Doty, Stevens and Bahr.

Ald. Doty moved adjournment.
