## Cookery Points

Steak and Mushroom Pudding.  
Steak and mushroom pudding is a  
good winter dish and is both appetiz-  
ing and satisfying. Cut tender rump  
steak into thin slices, and these again  
into medium sized squares. Cut thin  
slices of ham or bacon into still small-  
er squares. Spread the steak out on a  
floured board, place a piece of the ham  
or bacon on each square and sprinkle  
with a spiced seasoning made of two  
spoonful of black pepper and a salt-  
spoonful of mixed spice; then roll up  
tightly. Line a buttered baking-dish  
with pie crust and fill with alternate  
layers of meat rolls and mushrooms  
which have been peeled and cut in  
pieces. Pour in some good brown stock  
well flavored with vegetables. Cover  
with pie crust, pressing the edges firm-  
ly together after having moistened  
them with cold water. Place a piece  
of buttered paper over the pudding,  
then put on the cloth and steam steady-  
ly for four hours.
