LAW PROTECTS THE SONG BIRDS

Arrival of Songsters Makes the Warning Timely

Now that spring has come, bringing with it the robin, blue bird, thrush and other precious wild birds, the committee of the Highland Park Humane Society, desire to bring to the notice of the residents of Highland Park, but most especially the boys, the following state law.

An act for the protection of game, wild fowl and birds. Any person who shall, within the State, kill or catch, or have in his possession, living or dead, any wild bird or part of bird other than a game bird, or who shall purchase or expose for sale any such wild bird after it has been killed or caught shall, for each offense be subject to a fine of five dollars for each bird killed or caught or had in his or her possession, living or dead, or imprisoned for ten (10) days or both at the discretion of the judge.

The committee urge the co-operation of the public in preventing the killing of our wild birds and, when necessary, in the enforcing of the law.
