CALLS FILTRATION BEST PROTECTION

Harvard Professor Investigates Lake Cities Water Supply

George C. Whipple, professor of sanitary engineering in Harvard University and a consulting engineer of the city of New York, recently completed an exhaustive study of the water of Lake Michigan with a view to determining the best method of protecting the inhabitants of the cities and villages which use it from diseases which have come from use of lake water in the past and which have caused an untold number of deaths from typhoid and other diseases. During his study of lake water supplies he examined into water supplies not only in Chicago, but in Waukegan and all other towns and cities along the lake shore as far as Milwaukee.

As a result of his investigation, he discards all efforts at disinfection of the water as inefficient, and all attempts at purification of sewage, as both too expensive and also not efficient and decides that filtration is the only sure means within the financial reach, of the cities along the lake shore of purifying their water supply.
