Special Assessment Notice No. 220

Notice is hereby given to all persons interested that the city council of the City of Highland Park, County of Lake, and State of Illinois having ordered that the following local improvements be made to-wit: Grading, draining, curbing, providing with catch basins, constructing a macadam roadway having an asphalt surface (18 feet wide, including concrete gutters), constructing a reinforced concrete girder-type bridge, and otherwise improving Beach St. from the easterly line of the paved roadway in St. Johns Ave. as hereinafter provided easterly to the westerly line of Sheridan Rd. (excepting the site of the concrete bridge herein provided), St. Johns Ave. from the southerly line of Lincoln Ave. produced westerly across St. Johns Ave., southerly to the southerly line of Beach St. produced westerly across St. Johns Ave., Forest Ave. from the northerly line of Wade St. produced westerly, southerly to the easterly line of the paved roadway on St. Johns Ave. herein provided; Wade St. from the easterly line of the paved roadway in St. Johns Ave. herein provided, southeasterly to the southerly line of Beach St.; Linden Ave. from the east line of Forest Ave. southeasterly to the southerly line of Beach St. and a reinforced concrete bridge in Beach St. between Wade St. and Linden Ave., spanning that ravine in Beach St.; all in the city of Highland Park, County of Lake and State of Illinois. The ordinance for the same being on file in the office of the city clerk of said city and having applied to the county court of Lake County for an assessment of the costs of said improvement according to benefits, and an assessment thereof having been made and returned to said court, the final hearing thereon will be had on the 26th day of March A. D. 1915, or as soon thereafter as the business of the court will permit.

Said assessment is payable in ten (10) installments, with interest at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum on all installments from and after date of issue of first voucher. All persons desiring may file objections in said court before said day and may appear on the hearing and make their defense.
