**NEW SERVICE FOR WESTERN UNION**

**Usefulness of Telegraphic Money Transfer Service Increased by New Regulations**

During the past few years the Western Union Telegraph Company has been in the van of public service corporations in putting out new services to meet modern business and social demands. The company now announces another innovation for the benefit of its patrons. The Western Union Company annually transfers by telegraph an enormous amount of money and heretofore the senders of money have not been permitted to include in the transfers any communication of a business or personal character being required to be sent by separate message. Under the new arrangements, however, transfers between points in the United States may include such information and the same will be delivered to the payee at the time the transfer is paid. Through it, people will be enabled to transmit money quickly with proper instructions to meet banking obligations, pay insurance policies, guarantee purchases, accompany bids, purchase railroad, steamship and theater tickets, pay taxes, assessments and bills of all descriptions, make remittances to traveling salesmen and pupils attending distant schools, etc. There is practically no limit to the purposes for which this service is available. **SHIPPERS MUST HAVE CERTIFICATE**

**Under New Ruling Shipments of Cattle Cannot be Made Without Permit**  
 Chicago, February 13.

to the Newspapers:

The order of the secretary of agriculture, effective February 14, 1916, requires that no cattle, sheep, other ruminants, or swine shall be shipped, transported, or driven on foot or otherwise moved from that portion of the state of Illinois lying north of the northern boundaries of the counties of Calhoun, Jersey, Macoupin, Montgomery, Fayette, Effingham, Jasper and Crawford, to any other state or the District of Columbia, or to any public stock yards for purposes other than immediate slaughter unless accompanied by a certificate of inspection issued by an employe of the bureau of animal industry.

Doctor A. M. Casper is located at Lake Forest to conduct the inspection of animals to be shipped out of Lake county under the order of the secretary. Doctor Casper's headquarters is Spidel building; his phone number is Lake Forest 616; his postoffice address is Lake Forest, Ill.

No inspection is required for animals shipped for immediate slaughter. All cattle, sheep, other ruminants, and swine intended for stocking, feeding, dairying or breeding purposes must be inspected in the farms and certified before they are shipped.

Those who desire the services of Doctor Casper should make arrangements with him as far as POSSIBLE IN ADVANCE, as he has a large territory to cover.
