Extracts from Our Health Ordinances
The following are here reprinted from the "Revised Ordinances of the City of Highland Park":

Nuisances

It is hereby declared to be a nuisance:

"To so negligently conduct any business or use any premises in such a manner as to create an offensive smell or taint the air, and render it unwholesome or disagreeable to others.

"To cause or suffer the carcass of any animal, or any offal, garbage, filth or noxious substances to be collected, deposited, or to remain in any place, to the prejudice of others.

"For any person to permit or suffer any offal, filth, refuse, animal or vegetable matter which is liable to become putrid or offensive, or injurious to health, to remain for a longer period than six hours at any one time on any premises used or occupied by him.

"Whoever violates any clause, section or provision of this chapter by maintaining, or causing to be maintained, anything hereinbefore declared to be a nuisance, except where a penalty has been above specifically provided for, shall be fined not less than five dollars and not exceeding two hundred dollars for each offense."
