NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that bids will be received for the construction of a six (6) inch cast iron water main, with the necessary appurtenances, in St. Johns Avenue, beginning and connecting with the present four (4) inch water main ending opposite the southwesterly corner of Lot 19, Block 75, of F. P. Hawkins Addition, and extending from thence southerly parallel with and twenty-six (26) feet west of the easterly line of said St. Johns Avenue, for a distance of five hundred and fifty-two (552) feet, at which point it shall connect with an existing six (6) inch water main; in the City of Highland Park, County of Lake and State of Illinois, as a whole in accordance with the ordinance therefor. Said bids will be opened on the 22nd day of May A. D. 1916 at the hour of 5:45 o'clock P. M. at the office of the Board of Local Improvements in the City Hall of the City of Highland Park.

The specifications and blank proposals will be furnished at the office of the Board of Local Improvements in the City Hall in said City.

The contractor will be paid in bonds, which bonds will draw interest at the rate of five (5) per cent. per annum.

All proposals or bids must be accompanied by a certified check payable to the President of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Highland Park for the sum of not less than ten (10) per cent. of the aggregate of the proposal.

Said proposal must be delivered to the President of the Board of Local Improvements in open session of said Board at the time and place fixed herein for the opening of the same. No proposal or bid will be considered unless accompanied by check as herein provided.

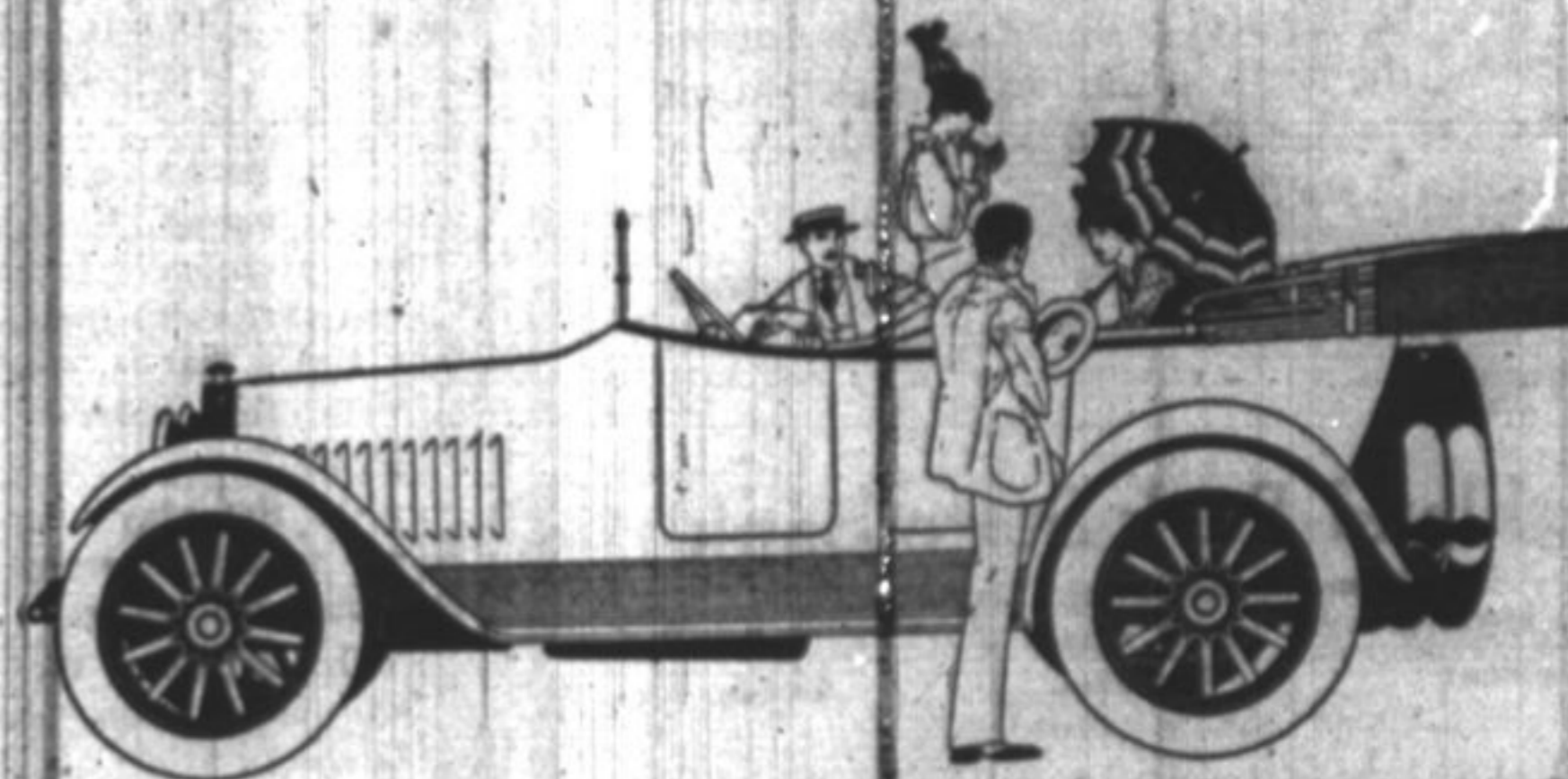
