Ossoli Club

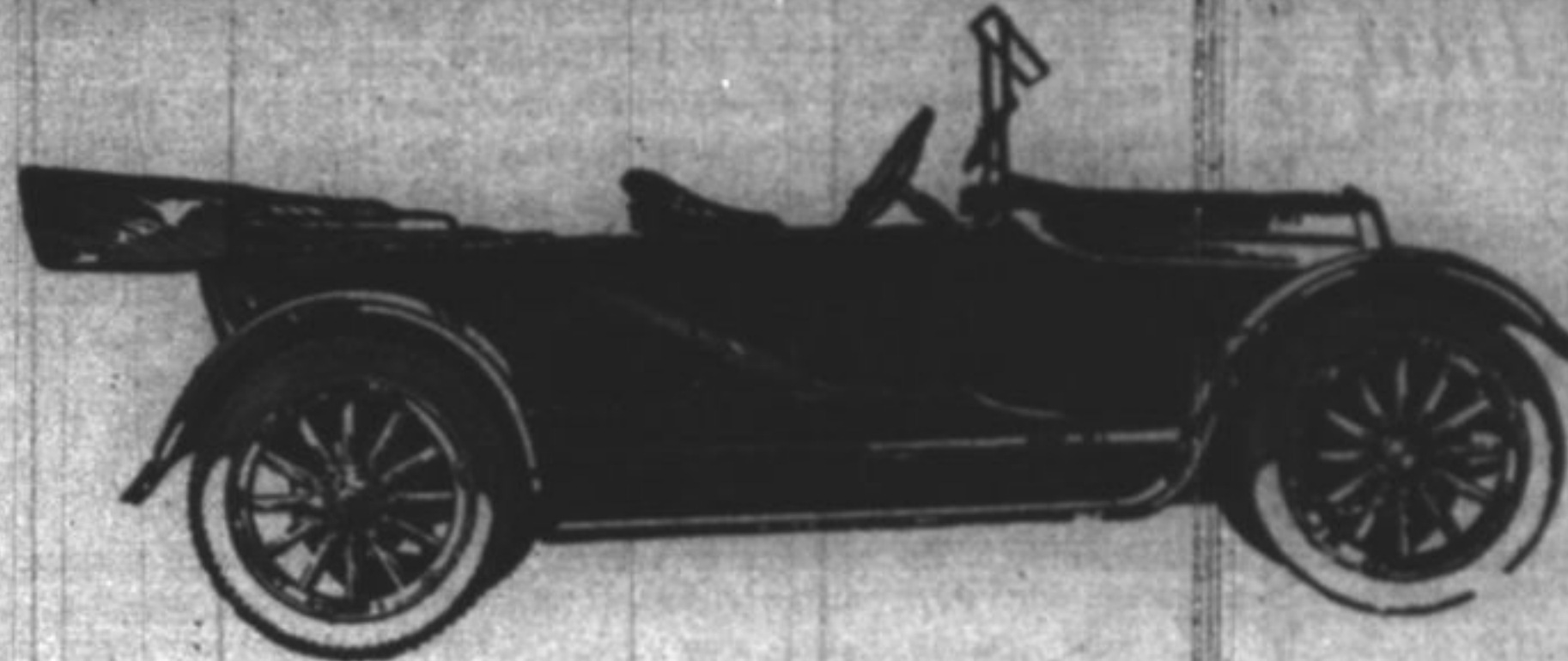
