Deviled Mutton
Cut the cold mutton in rather thick slices, dip each in a "deviled" mixture of vinegar, French mustard, salt, pepper and a dash of sugar. Turn over the slices in the sauce several times; dip in rather thick batter, and fry as you would fritters. Drain off the fat and serve hot.

Liver Balls
Fry the liver ten minutes in butter, press through a sieve and one-half teaspoonful of finely chopped parsley, salt and pepper and one egg yolk. Shape in very small balls. Egg and crumb them and fry in deep fat.
