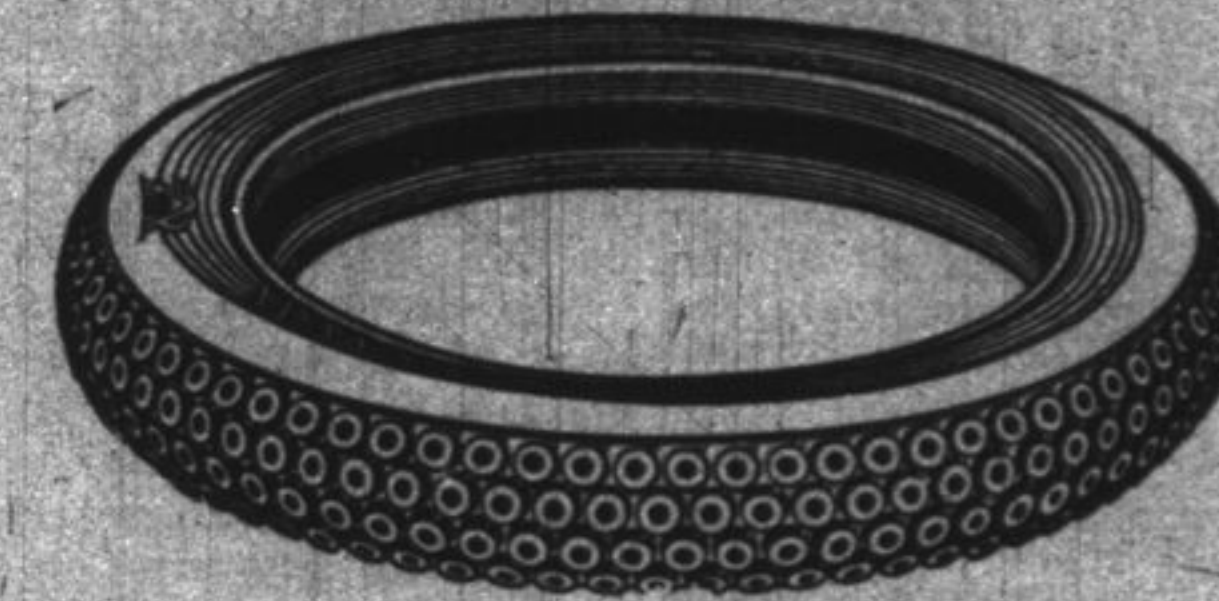
Hazel Ave., near St. John's Ave.
