# INCOME TAX

Prepare and File Your Schedule

In accordance with the provisions of the Federal Revenue Act, every unmarried person with an income of \$1,000 or over and every married person with an income of \$2,000 or over must file a schedule during the months of January and February with the Internal Revenue Collector.



The public will be interested to know that an official representative of the Treasury Department will visit Highland Park and remain here from February 8th. to the 12th ready to give aid and advice in the preparation of such Income Tax schedules.
