From the United States Government comes the patriotic call to every young man in Illinois—16 to 21 years of age—to join the U. S. Boys Working Reserve and help win the war. This call is made to all of "Reserve" age whether attending school or employed in non-essential work. Every full-blooded, patriotic young man who is under military age is called upon to enroll during this week. Let there not be an idle boy in Illinois while so many are giving their lives for Democracy.

This week will be general enrollment week, and boys who can be spared from other non-productive work they are now engaged in are urged to enroll as "Reserve Volunteers" and get ready to answer this call for work on farms.

This great war is a war of sustenance and endurance. It is a food war and our farmers will not be able to raise the crops expected of them unless they get good help from the towns and cities.

Herbert Hoover has called the U. S. Boys' Working Reserve "Our second line of defense." Prof. Spillman, Chief of the Bureau of Farm Management, says "Push as hard as you can." Every school teacher, every "Reserve" director and worker is expected to do his utmost to answer this call.

Parents are urged to encourage their sons of "Reserve" age to undertake this work for their country. These boys will go to good Illinois farm homes and will live under wholesome moral and social conditions. Every agency in the state is being employed to look after their welfare and see that every "Reserve Volunteer" on an Illinois farm is encouraged to do his best and is happy and contented.

School principals and teachers, public librarians and executives of the Y. M. C. A., Knights of Columbus or other organizations, will be authorized with proper credentials as enrolling officers.

Enlistment of "Reserve Volunteers" can now be made at the Illinois State Council of Defense Building, in Chicago, in person or by letter, and literature can be obtained there, giving the details of the U. S. Boys' Working Reserve.

must appear in relation to the true understanding of God as inevitably to the figure four appears in relation to the numbers two times.

Definition of Law

The term law may be and is variously defined, but in its true and highest meaning, may be said to be that which manifests or makes known the enduring stability of Truth, the perfect continuity of Life, the unchanging unity or oneness of Love; in other words, that which reflects or manifests the infinite presence of all-inclusive creative Mind, or God.

One may insist, however, at this point that law should represent the substantiality of matter.

Matter: Instability, Disappearance

The term matter may be defined as the permanent, ultimate, form or primal state of what is called matter. Physical science has come upon numerous disappearing hypotheses. To illustrate this, no very long ago physical science looked upon the atom as representing the ultimate form or primal state of matter. Of comparatively recent date, however, advanced scientific thought has superseded and displaced the atom as the ultimate form of matter. The electron has never been seen by the physical sense, but is very little indeed is known concerning the electron except that it indicates the passing of what yesterday was looked upon and accepted as physical science as the private state of matter.

In other words, in attempting to arrive at the permanent, ultimate, form or primal state of what is called matter, physical substance, matter is seen to disappear. Prof. Wilhelm Ostwald, a well-known authority, states in substance on page 242 of his "Outline of General Chemistry," Ed. 1912, that the conception of matter is too indefinite for it to be regarded as one of the conceptions of phenomena. Please remember that this is a statement of physical science regarding matter, and that matter is the foundation of physical science.

Another, one views the immediate or local forms of matter, with which humanity is environed, also the material residue of ancient ages, and discovers in each of these emphatic evidences of the changing, shifting, and loosening of matter, and is drawn inevitably to the conclusion that there is a force continually at work and destroying the assumed stability of material laws.

Finally, these statements may be of interest, I desire to say that they are not made from the standpoint of Christian Science.

Scientific Deductions

Mrs. Eddy did not arrive at her understanding of the true nature of Christian Science from any such materialistic deductions as these. As early as the year 1866 she made the denial of the substantiality of matter, and to affirm, yet, thereafter physical science has announced the disappearance of any ultimate form or primal state of matter, recognizing to the physical sense, but from an entirely different basis, and with entirely different results, for while physical science has pursued matter to its point of disappearance and finds itself in the rather equivocal position of standing upon something which, even though it may be real, does not exist in reality. Christian Science, recognizing man and the universe created and forever sustained in perfect continuity by infinite Mind, or God, has established an enduring substance of the increase of which "there shall be no end."

If Mrs. Eddy's work had consisted only in establishing the place and use of the Bible in the cure of disease, she would be considered a most remarkable woman indeed, and one to whom humanity would render a tribute of love and respect.

Grateful Multitudes

In addition to the there are hundreds of thousands of men and women and children throughout the world who have been healed of their sickness and pain, healed of their sorrow and grief, healed of their sin and misery, healed of disease and death. Mrs. Eddy has been a citizen of the world (See Science and Health). And it is not a strange thing that these who have been thus healed should treasure with sincere gratitude the gift of Christian Science which the kind friend and teacher who has laid upon the star of humanity.

Giving

If there is one word which might more than another indicate something of the character and scope of Mrs. Eddy's work, it may be the word giving. Mrs. Eddy was always ready and willing to give to a cause that was worthy. Above all, she was always giving, giving, giving, of the gift of perfect creative Mind, or God—the law which manifests and makes known the enduring stability of Truth, the perfect continuity of Life, the perfect oneness of Love. And this is the law, my friends, which Christian Science declares to you; the law which, when properly understood and applied, abrogates and sets aside the false, mortal consciousness, "from the beginning," abrogates and sets aside the false material law, which, together with the evidence of its instability—the pain in the head—disappears, and in this way only will "the first heaven and the first earth," the instability of matter, pass away.

Christian Science Assurance

When we speak of the real man, the real existence of the real law, please do not understand that it is the purpose of Christian Science to destroy or deprive you of anything which may seem necessary and good to you. It is not the purpose of Christian Science to destroy, but to fulfill. Christian Science has come to establish the recognition and demonstration of man and the universe as created by God.

Relation to the Bible

The question is often asked, Why do Christian Scientists refer so freely and continuously to the Bible? There are several reasons for this: In the first place, the Christian Scientist has learned and is learning to depend on the Bible. He has come to love with a sincere devotion this book, the leaves of which have been turned and studied by our fathers and forefathers before him; that it has a message of definite good when interpreted rightly, and that this right interpretation is bringing to him glad and infinite meanings.

Simplicity and Consistency

Mrs. Eddy's faith and trust in God, and her confidence in the ever-present divine love, was the source of the faith and trust and confidence of little child, and this, together with the courage, strength and zeal of one who had caught the vision of great purpose, gave her the most tender and loving heart, and yet the most compassionate, firm and constructive character of her time.

By far the majority of those who have been healed of disease through Christian Science have come to know Mrs. Eddy by means of her writings, in all of which there is to be found continual help and inspiration. And above all, a personal study of the statement of Principle and practice throughout. This consistency, my friends, is not the careful, studious consistency of those who feared to commit themselves to the simple straightforward consistency of one who heard the demands of God, and neither hesitated nor feared to correlate these demands in the Science of being, or humanity as an eternal legacy of God.

Science of Being Necessary

Humanity has come to recognize that there is a science for very nearly everything in the world except human existence. It has learned that there is a science of music and a science of numbers, and the discerning among us may be disposed, and harmony established upon these may be dispelled and harmony established.

This same humanity, sick of its sufferings and wearied with its superstitions, has come to realize that there is a science of hope—may there not be a science available whereby the disease, sickness, and distress of human existence may be dispelled, and happiness, harmony and health established in place of gloom with at least equal permanence and certainty?
