will be asked on June 24th to vote on the question of annexation of Ravinia Highlands and First Addition to Ravinia Highlands, adjoining Highland Park on the south and west.

A number of responsible business men who are purchasers of lots have expressed their desire to build, but found they could not owing to lack of sewers and city water.

It is not likely that these purchasers will build \$50,000 homes—such people would buy a lake front lot or a large estate on one of the beautiful ravines—but there are many attractive building sites in Ravinia Highlands and Chicago business men want to utilize them for homes and should not be deprived of the opportunity.

The lots are laid out in units of 40 and 50 feet frontage (there are five one-acre lots), but many owners have two and three lots making a roomy building site capable of accommodating substantial homes with attractive lawns and shrubs.

The annexation of this territory would foster and encourage the growth and prosperity of the City of Highland Park.
