## RULES OF THE CONTEST

- Time of contest—June 1st to 28th inclusive.
- The subscribers, signing pledge cards must be eighteen years of age or over, provided that the pledge of any person under that age will be counted if fulfillment is guaranteed by responsible person.
- The solicitors competing for prizes must have attended some school during the whole school year of 1917-18.
- Pledge cards must be sent into the local postmaster at least once each week.
- Cards must be legible and clear.
- The campaign will be COUNTY-WIDE and solicitors may work anywhere within the confines of Lake County.
- There will be two sets of CAPITAL PRIZES offered—a first, second and third prize for the City district including Waukegan, North Chicago, Lake Bluff, Highland Park, and Lake Forest, and a first, second and third prize for the Rural District comprising the balance of the county.
- Waukegan Chamber of Commerce will appoint a committee of judges who will select prizes for each postoffice district and for each school in the county.
- Prizes will be awarded on the basis of total amount subscribed.
- Competition for prizes is open to school children of common, high and preparatory grades only.
- Awards will be made only on the basis of subscriptions made after June 1st, and to and including June 28th.
- The totals of each solicitor's pledges are to be tabulated in each Post Office District by the Postmaster or Committee Chairman, and certified to the County Chairman of War Savings Stamps Committee, North Chicago, Illinois.
