together from every town in county to organize the Lake County Forest Preserve Committee, be the forest preserve campaign, and tells of the step which must be tak-

en to secure the preserve. "People are turning back with sigh of relief to civic pursuits," says

"We have learned one thing, if we have learned nothing else from the war, namely, that if it is desirable something for the public good on a large scale we can do it and that we can raise the money with which to do it.

"The proposed Lake County Forest Preserve is a plan not only for future but for present recreational grounds, even before it becomes a vital necessity because of the growth in population. We will be able today to use these proposed recreational

"The Cook County Forest Preseive has been organized for a long enough time to demonstrate its great contribution to the civic betterment of Cook county. I believe it is fully as important for Lake County to have its forest preserve as for Cook County or any other community to have room for its expansion. It takes but a few generations for people to be deprived of their vitality if kept from the soil.
