### DIRECTORY GIVES CITY NEARLY 4000 GAIN

Highland Park Second Largest City in Lake County, According to F. K. Bumstead

That Highland Park's population has reached a total of 10,560 was the statement made yesterday by F. W. Bumstead, compiler of the Lake County directory. The tenth issue of Mr. Bumstead's directory is in the hands of the binders and will be ready for distribution the first part of next week. There has been a marked increase in population since the last issue of the Bumstead directory in 1916.

The following figures show the present population of lake shore cities in Lake County as compared to their population in 1916:

The directory contains merely the names of those who are eighteen years of age or older. In former issues it has been Mr. Bumstead's plan to multiply the number of those over the age of eighteen by 2 1-4 to arrive at the actual population. Mr. Bumstead says experience has shown him that 2 1-4 does not give a fair idea of the population so this year he is multiplying by 2 3-4 which he says is very conservative.

#### Lake Bluff Smaller

The figures show that Lake Bluff has lost in population since the last directory was issued. In Highland Park, Waukegan and Zion City, however, it is seen that the population has increased to a marked extent.

The directory this year does not list the residents of all cities and towns in the county as usual, but instead it has been made purely a north shore directory, listing only the residents of the Lake Shore cities in the county.
