ON January 21, 1919, the Postmaster General established a new interstate and intrastate telephone toll rates. The intrastate rates were not charged because of an injunction issued by the Superior Court of Cook County.

The recent decision of the United States Supreme Court empowers the Postmaster General to fix telephone rates, and the intrastate toll rates formerly announced by the Postmaster General will now apply in the State of Illinois.

Read the booklet on "The Northern Lakes" which comprises Wisconsin, Minnesota, upper Michigan, Iowa and Illinois. Or, boarding houses and hotels, lists of gun clubs, golf clubs, etc. Have you a longing for the seashore? Take "New Jersey Seashore Resorts" or "Along New England Shores", north and south of Boston. Do you want to go to the lakes and mountains? How about "Colorado and Utah Mountains", "The Catskill Mountains", or "The Poconos, Eaglesmere, Delaware Water Gap, Chataqua Lake. . . ." "Adirondacks and Thousand Islands", "Summer Resorts in the Blue Ridge and Allegheny Mountains", "Lakes and Mountains of New England", "Summer Resorts of the Southern Region", "Niagara Falls and Highlands of Ontario."

look them over. If you can't leave town, read the travel books and go in spirit, the trip will do you good. Books on fishing, camping, and outdoor life are on the same table in the fiction room, and you may take home with you all that you can carry.

"The Path on the Rainbow" is the gay title of a volume of verse collected by G. W. Brown from all the American Indian tribes. Some of the verse is very fragmentary, so fragmentary, and so primitive, that it would almost be bold enough to be included in the volumes of the Imagists. It is colorful and imagistic, but after all, Indian. However, others of the poems are more satisfying to poetry lovers who have not been jolted from their early-Victorian point of view. "The Lost Lagoon" is a gem.

"It is dusk on the Lost Lagoon, And we two dreaming in the dusk away. Beneath the drift of a twilight gray— Beneath the drowse of an ending day And the curve of a golden moon." "It is dark on the Lost Lagoon, And gone are the depths of haunting blue, The grouping gulls, and the old Canoe, The singing firs and the dusk and— you, And gone is the golden Moon."

That is one of the things that make life worth while; but another, and so different that to mention them in too abrupt succession is startling, is "The Inventor's Manual" by George M. Hopkins. It is a guide for inventors, in perfecting their inventions, taking out their patents, and disposing of them, and cautions as to pitfalls for the unwary. In brief: "How to work a patent to make it pay. It is an excellent little handbook. Have you ever been advised by admiring friends "You'd better patent that"? If you have, you had better read this book. At the back, and quite independent (it is intended for advertising) is an excellent list of reliable books on technical and vocational subjects; everything from aviation and automobiles to recipe books.
