two snipers dead as a door nail, one fellow had three holes in his forehead. That meant some of us had hit the mark. The other fellow was hit once, and the hand we saw fly in the air was the hand of the sniper's wife, who had a hole right through the middle of her hand. She tried to tell us they were up there looking at the fight across the river, but it didn't go very far. After they heard what we were doing to all the snipers, they cut it out.

We didn't take any chances, however, and shot them like dogs. We stayed up all night and didn't have any more trouble until daybreak. We were lined up along the river when we spotted two men crawling in the weeds on the other side. They were making for a trench and had to go over a little hill to reach their objective. One of the fellows was picked to do the shooting, and he was an expert whom we nicknamed "Scratch." The first had just started over the hill when he made a neat shot and the old stick threw up both hands and dropped over the other one, ducked, and a few minutes later he tried the same thing and the same thing happened to him. The officer in charge would say, "Who got that one?" We all thought it was a good joke.

That finished the fighting there. We stayed at the bridge until two o'clock and then they shipped us down the river to Ft. Hancock where we are now, seventy miles from El Paso. We are waiting for Villa here. He has to go through a pass to get back to Mexico City.

It sure is fun, all of it, and you don't need to worry about me because they are not going to get a shot at me. We have too many on guard and we all shoot to kill. We have 1000 men here at the Fort and one of us is better than twenty snipers. All we have to do is to hit one, the others run. That's when we get a good shot at them.

Keep sending my mail to the old address because we will leave here in a few days for camp. Will write again when we get back to camp. We aren't in any danger so don't worry. I will tell you a lot more about it when I get back home. What do the Chicago papers say? This is all the truth, so you need not be afraid to publish it in the Highland Park Press, and then you can send me a copy of the paper. Hope every one is well and happy.

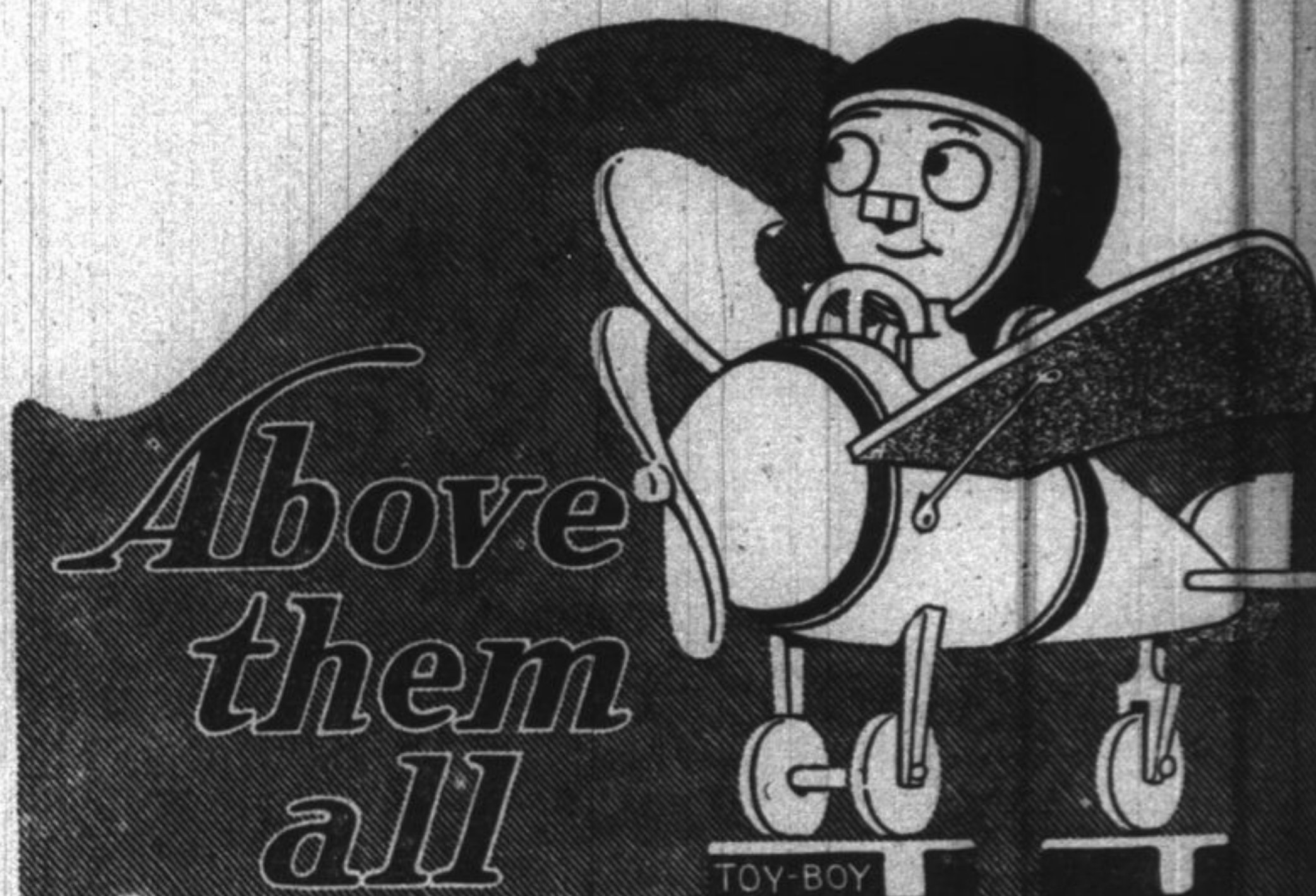
