Of course a statement of fact is always more convincing. If the ad writer offers "Suits for \$30.00, worth \$40.00," many people will accept his statement in view of the record of his store. Still there will always be some suspicious people, who would claim that any seller of goods is inclined to exaggerate their value.

But if an ad writer says that a certain lot formerly priced at \$40, is now marked down to \$30, or that a standard line usually selling at \$40 has been bought at a sacrifice so it can be sold for \$30, here is a definite statement of fact that carries conviction to everyone. Anyone would know that no advertiser on the north shore would dare make such a statement, if it were not strictly true.
