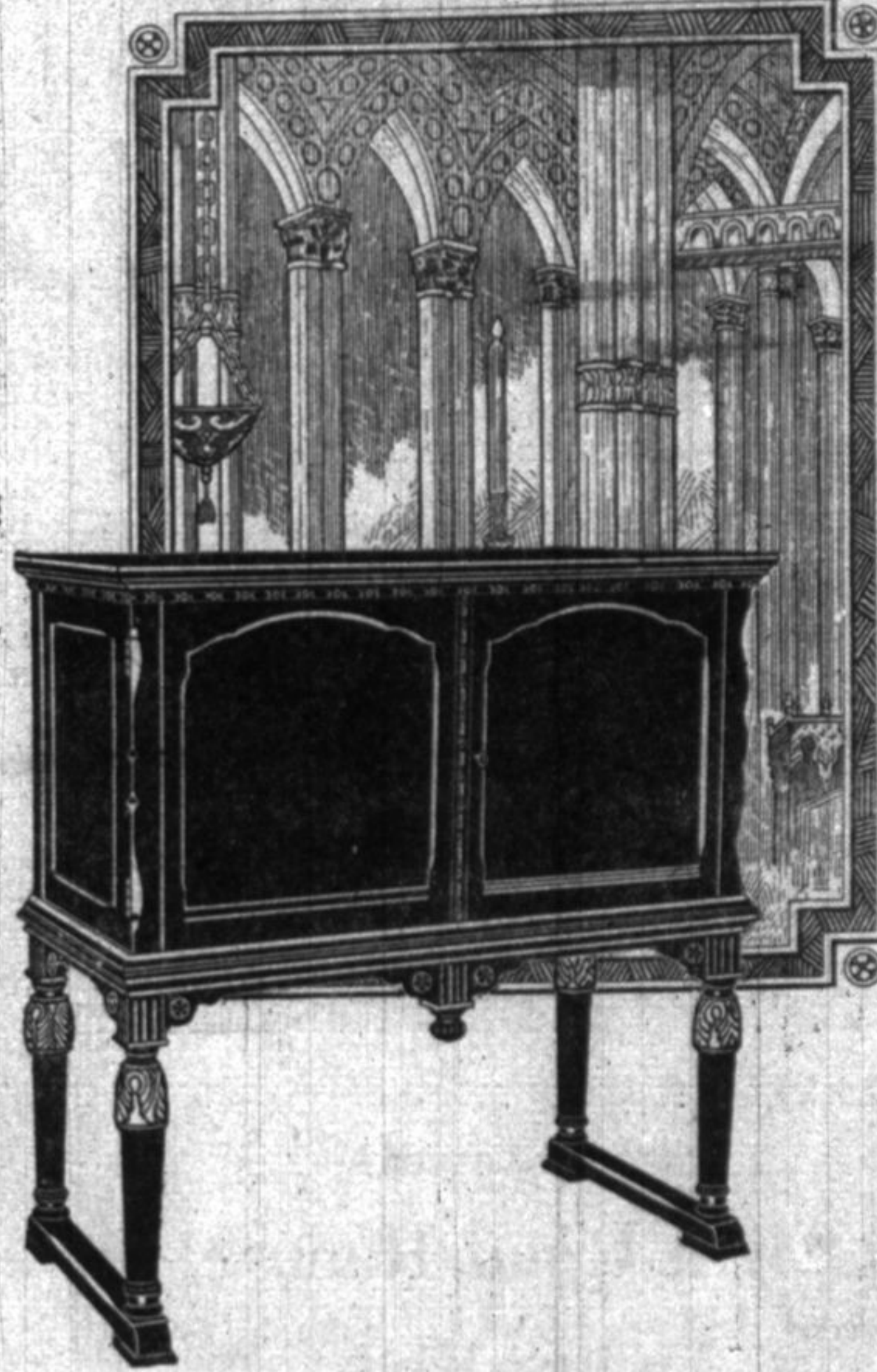

## LIEUT. GOV. OGLESBY MAKES VISIT HERE

DENOUNCES TAMMANYISM

Candidate for Republican Nomination for Governor Addresses Followers at Mass Meeting

Lieutenant Governor John G. Oglesby, candidate for the Republican nomination for governor of Illinois, spoke to a crowd of enthusiastic followers at a Republican mass meeting, held Tuesday morning in the community center rooms.

Unfortunately word that he was coming to Highland Park was received until late Monday, and the intervening time was too short to make the lieutenant-governor's visit generally known.

In his pleasing manner and plain frank style of speech, the listener found a man very much to their liking. Lieut. Gov. Oglesby spoke of the political situation in Illinois, and denounced the "Tammanyism" of the Thompson faction. The text of his speech follows:

My Fellow Citizens of Illinois:

I appreciate the pleasure of this opportunity to bring to you a personal announcement of my candidacy for the Republican nomination for governor of Illinois, and as thoroughly brief time will permit, to present to you the platform upon which my candidacy is based.

Tammanyism in Illinois. While there are many problems, issues which, under ordinary circumstances, would engage the attention of the voters of this State, I feel, as I believe that you feel, the most conspicuous and important issue confronting the people of Illinois, is especially the Republican party, Illinois, "Shall the people of Illinois continue in control of their party their affairs and their government or shall we become subservient to a Thompson-Tammany machine of Chicago?"

Upon these issues I have every reason to believe that the Republican party at the Primary in September will, in a most emphatic way, let be understood once and for all (Continued on Page 8)

## MINERAL WATER SOLD TO CHICAGO COMPANY

LARGE CONTRACT SIGNED

Local Well Begins Supplying Hydrox Firm With Artesian Water; Filling Local Orders Free

The deep rock artesian well owned by the Nectar Beverage company, S. Second st., is to furnish a regular supply of mineral water for the Hydrox company of Chicago, according to a contract recently entered between the two companies.

Sunday morning three large trucks from the Hydrox company came the first loads, the initial order being for five thousand gallons. The three and five gallon bottles were filled a little over five hours.

The Hydrox company is one of the best authorities on drinking water the country, and bottles only the best water; and that under the most sanitary conditions. The well, owned by the Nectar Beverage company is said to be one of the mineral water supplies in the State. It was drilled in 1915, and has been supplying many customers since that time.

The well is 243 feet deep and one-half inches in diameter. The bottom 68 feet is through solid rock. The well has a daily capacity of 900 gallons. The water comes at 49 degrees Fahrenheit — only degrees above freezing.

The analysis shows that the water obtained in Highland Park is one of the best balanced mineral waters the state. It is absolutely free of organic matter, and contains no forming bacteria.

For the rest of August the Nectar company is giving water free to the resident of Highland Park, the stipulation being that the customer bring his own container, and that perfectly clean.
