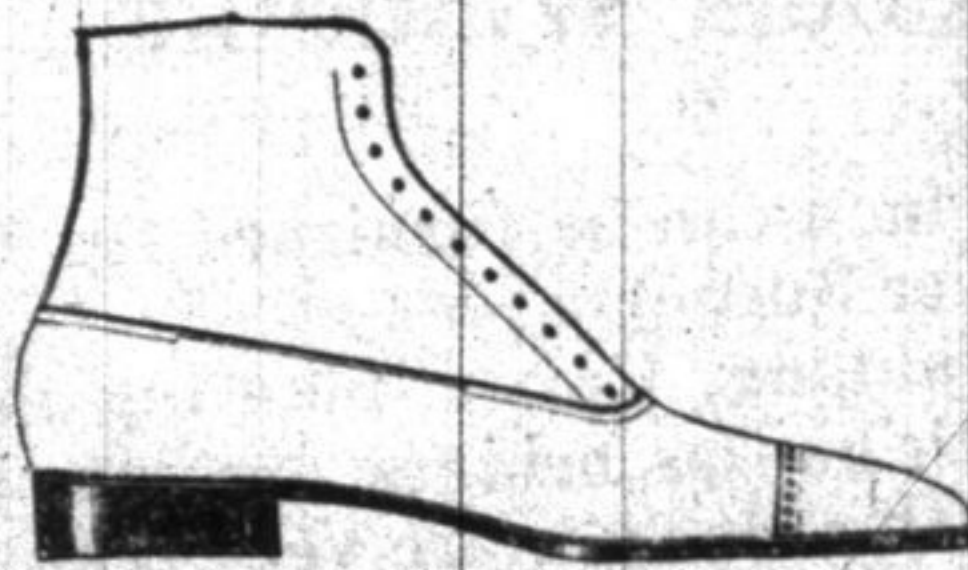

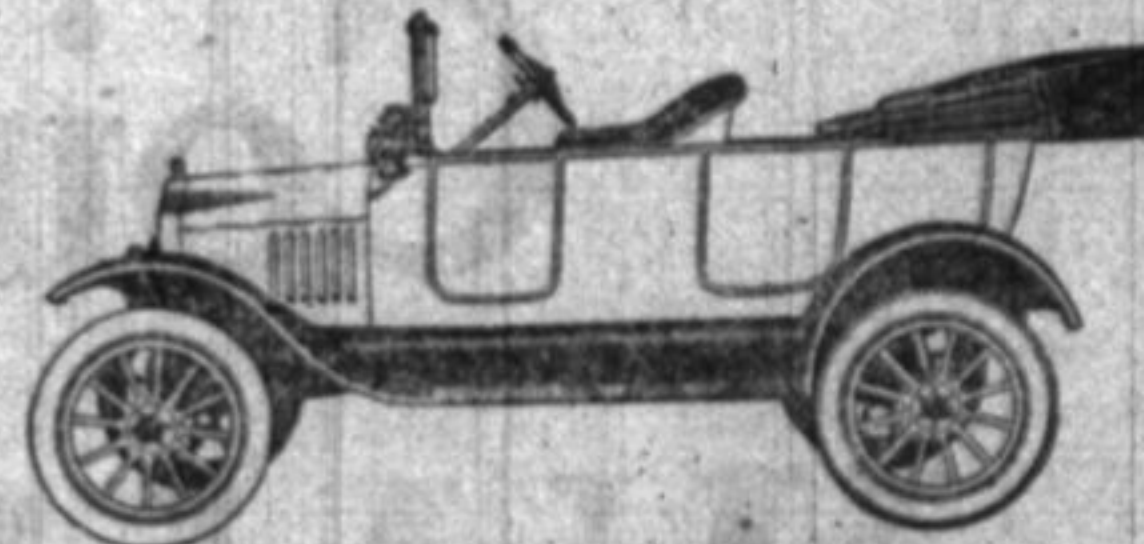

## WETS WOULD CONTROL NEXT LEGISLATURE

Are Carrying On As Extensive a Campaign as Ever Against Prohibition

The Legislative Situation  
Nominating petitions filed indicate that the wets will fight hard for the control of the next legislature. A comparison of the situation district by district this year with former years shows that the wets are carrying on as extensive a campaign as ever against prohibition. Their purpose is to prevent the passage of any additional enforcement legislation, to block enforcement appropriations and if possible to repeal the search and seizure law. The liquor forces have served notice through their organizations that they intend to wipe out the Illinois enforcement act which sets a one and one half of one percent limit in order that they may benefit from national beer and wine legislation in case Congress is won by the wets. The greatest danger confronting prohibition enforcement is that too many dries may stay at home on Primary election day, Sept. 15, instead of going to the polls and voting for candidates endorsed by the Anti-Saloon League.

The Congressional Situation  
Practically all of the seventeen Illinois Congressmen who voted to submit the prohibition amendment are opposed for re-election in their districts by wet candidates. The Congressional program of the wets is to amend the Volstead Act by changing the one half of one percent alcoholic limit so as to permit the manufacture and sale of beer and wine. This program is based on the decision of the Supreme Court that Congress has the power to define what shall be considered as intoxicating under the 18th Amendment. It is not generally known by dries that the part of the Volstead Act setting the one half of one percent alcoholic limit was passed by a very narrow margin. Enough dry congressmen have already been defeated for renomination in other states to make possible the repeal of the one half of one percent limit if the wets make gains in Illinois and several other states. It is also not generally realized that the Volstead Act can be amended by a majority vote.

One eighth as many arrests for drunkenness during the first dry year. Police reports from six large Illinois cities wet before July 1st, 1919, show that only one eighth as many were arrested for drunkenness during the first dry year as compared with the last wet year. The figures are as follows:

In Chicago arrests for disorderly

conduct (including drunkenness) were reduced from 46,000 during the last wet year to 26,550 during the first dry year.

## WORK STOPPED ON BELVIDERE ROAD

Failure to Get Material Reason For Delay in New County Road

Inability to get paving materials has made it necessary to halt the paving of Belvidere Road. Charles Russell, county superintendent of highways asserted that work had to be stopped on the improvement last week. About two weeks ago it was announced that the contractors were using their surplus supply of gravel and sand because shipments from Waukegan, Wis., ordered long ago, had failed to arrive. This surplus supply has been exhausted.

At the present time there is about 1 1/4 miles of road to be paved. It is asserted that the contractor requires 2500 yards of gravel and 1500 yards of sand. The freight car shortage is what is holding up the shipments. Mr. Russell is doing all in his power to assist the contractors in getting the materials.

## LOTUS IN BLOOM AT GRASS LAKE, ANTIOCH

Just get a boat and row out through the weeds where the small boys are fishing, and before you know it, you will reach the lotus patch. The plant blooms only once a year, and is in full bloom now.
