

Abraham Lincoln

was forced to pay 25 per cent to 40 per cent for money with which to defray the expenses of the Civil War because the money was controlled by private interests.



FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT

Woodrow Wilson paid only 3 and one half per cent to 4 and three fourths per cent for money with which to defray the expenses of the late World-War.
