No New Buildings Captain Merillat stated that at present no new construction work is contemplated, with the exception of completing the installation of curbing and general resurfacing of roads within the boundaries of the post.

Recently bids were asked for from outside contractors for the erection of a new pier to take the place of the time-worn, ram-shackle structure which at present juts into the lake from the Fort Sheridan beach, but the cost of the work was considered prohibitive at this time and no steps will be taken in the matter of erecting a new pier until such time as building costs decline materially.

Buildings 50, 106, 107 and 108 are now being remodelled for use headquarters of the Sixth Corps, which will be transferred to Fort Sheridan on or about October 15.

Buildings 1, 2 ,121, 122, and 123 are now being renovated and given a thorough going over in preparation for the transfer of the patients who will be taken over by the Station Hospital when the general hospital closes.


